

The March 5, 2019 regular meeting of the Cogan House Township Board of Supervisors was called to order at 7:00 PM, at the Municipal Building by Chairman Howard Fry, Board Members attending were Howard Fry, Daniel Roupp & Robert Emery.

Public Comment: None

The Minutes from the February 5, 2019 regular meeting, Bill List and Treasurer's Report were approved and accepted. Supervisor Roupp made a motion to approve them Supervisor Emery seconded, voted 3 – 0 and passed.

Correspondence: American Rescue Workers requested to put a clothing donation box here at the Township. The Supervisors agreed to give it a 3 month trial to be sure it would not turn into a trash area. PennDot sent letters advising there were ample signage for the Route 184 sign and does not require additional signage for the turn off of Route 287. Supervisor Fry stated he would talk with PennDot and see if anything could be done due to the people still turning around at the Guillaume driveway. Received bridge paperwork showing that Buckhorn will be inspected later in the year. William Lubricants will be moving to a new location in Sayer, PA. Cleanscapes advised that if the township would join a membership they would come out with volunteers to pick up trash along the roads.

EMA Coordinator/Hazardous Mitigation/West Branch: Iva requested a copy of the Bill List and Treasurer's report, the Secretary advised would be able to give to her after they are approved in the meeting. She was advised by Mark Lipka that when she is out and about and she sees where someone is digging and she thinks is unsafe she has the authority to shut them down and get it inspected. She announced there is a Volunteer Banquet and Quarterly Meeting on March 28 at Holiday Inn and a training in Jersey Shore for Pipeline and 811.

OLD BUSINESS: Resolution for Amendment Stormwater Plan where 3 paragraphs were added Section 302.A. 7 through 9. Copies of this may be seen or requested from the Township Secretary. Supervisor Emery made a motion to adopt the Resolution for the Amendment and Supervisor Roupp Seconded voted 3 – 0 and passed.

NEW BUISNESS: Deardorff Subdivision the Supervisors reviewed his plans with No Comments.

NOTICE OF INTENT: Alta advised of a request for permit for a staging area on the Short Sock property, SWN Renewing a Drilling Permit for Jackson Township Brown 5H pad.

Range Resources advised of Consumptive Water Use for Cornwall B Unit #1H – 4H well pad not to exceed 2,000,000 gal per day.
