

The April 2, 2019 regular meeting of the Cogan House Township Board of Supervisors was called to order at 7:00 PM, at the Municipal Building by Chairman Howard Fry, Board Members attending were Howard Fry, Daniel Roupp and Robert Emery. The minutes of the March 5, 2019 regular meeting along with the bill list and treasurer's report was approved. Daniel made the motion to approve them and Robert Seconded.

Public Comment: Supervisor Roupp expressed concern about the recycling for the plastic. We will be endanger of losing our recycling due to improper discarding of plastic bags in the plastic bin. Plastic bags get tangled up in their equipment and causes damage to the machinery and down time for sorting it out. He also advised would be checking the cameras and contacting the residents that are the main responsible parties doing it. Chad Riley attended the meeting at the request of Iva Guillaume due to some concern about her resignation from EMA Coordinator. Iva advised that the Neighborhood Crime Watch was amended in 1978 and they do not actually police the area but residents are advised to contact the State Police or 911 with any concerns. They should not contact the township at all. Supervisor Fry expressed concern with the Code Inspections requiring a Sprinkler in a new built home and explained the cost would be terrific for people to do. This was brought up at PSATS for resolutions. EMA Coordinator/Hazardous Mitigation/West Branch: None due to Iva resignation but she will still remain on the crime watch committee.

Road Master's Report: Supervisor Roupp and the crew used the Peterbilt and Loader to fix potholes on Stryker Road had to purchase a load of stone for this road maintenance. Alta Energy brought in brooms and did all paved roads that they have leased. Alta also donated a tri-axle of salt due to a storm that was approaching in a few days.

Old Business: None

New Business: 2018 Audit completed no one came to review. Supervisors agreed to put out for bid the EDP-30 oil for dust control. Supervisor Roupp made motion to bid Supervisor Emery seconded, voted 3-0 and passed. May call Special Meeting to open bids since the weather may cooperate with us to have applied soon. They decided that Buckhorn should be the first road done when it is ready. A possible weight limit deduction on Buckhorn since Range is not helping with the road.
