

The November 6, 2019 regular meeting of the Cogan House Township Board of Supervisors was called to order at 7:00 PM, at the Municipal Building by Chairman Howard Fry, Board Members attending were Daniel Roupp and Robert Emery. Residents attending: Jerry DeMorat, Mary Gregory, Robert Bertin SEO, Tom Sherman and the Youmans. Pledge of Allegiance was given followed by Public Comment was given by Brian Ferris he dropped off the signed contract with the Liberty Volunteer Fire Company wanted to put a face to the Company. The recreation committee will no longer partner with WB EM team with the small game of chance tickets due to some changes in rules and they will not renew. Supervisor Emery made a motion to approve the October 1, 2019, the bill list and Treasurer's Report, Supervisor Roupp Seconded and voted and passed 3 – 0 Vote.

Correspondence: Received the Salary Survey from PSATS, PA Game Commission advised of a bridge over an unnamed tributary to Larry's Creek will be repaired a new deck and steel beam bridge. DEP advised of the final report for Bobst Mountain Hunting Club where Range Resources had a cleanup for spillage and was approved. Planning and Community Development has included Plunkett's Creek Township within the Zoning Partnership. Markosky Engineering applied for a permit to replace 2 pipes. One on SR 1040 and the other on State Rt. 287. Supervisors questioned this and requested the secretary to call and confirm these application at which time on November 7, 2019 the office stated these were after the fact they already were completed. Supervisor Fry and Supervisor Roupp advised they attended the Dirt & Gravel Training on October 30 & 31, 2019. Unique advised of a breakfast seminar for their product. EMA/Hazardous Mitigation there was none; however Howard had asked if Jerry DeMorat may be interested in taking over the EMA position. She did not think she would be able to do it due to she travels throughout the year but would pass information along to see if anybody else in interested.

Road Masters Report: Still brushing along the ROW of the Township roads to get ready for plowing in the winter. Looking for a tar buggy the paved roads will need this for sure next year. They received lots of kudos for the roads in the township.

New Business: 2020 Budget completed and need to advertise Supervisor Roupp made a motion to advertise Supervisor Emery seconded voted 3 – 0 passed. TCC form will be filled out at Organizational Meeting. Supervisors discussed whether to put an Ordinance together for Cutting Trees and Brush along the roads for safety concerns. Supervisor Emery made a motion to move forward with the Ordinance, Supervisor Fry Seconded voted 3 – 0 passed. They advise the secretary to forward a sample to the Solicitor for review. McTish-Kunkel requested permit for Road Occupancy to cut Wolfe Run and Taylor Road. Taylor was just paved and wondered why could not bore instead of cut. Supervisor requested a meeting with them and Alta. Need the Contractor and Stone Bid to be advertised for 2020. Supervisor Roupp made a motion for the Stone Bid to be advertised Supervisor Emery Seconded voted 3 – 0 passed. Supervisor Emery made a motion for the Contractor Bid to be advertised Supervisor Roupp Seconded and adding a tar buggy for sealing in it. Voted 3 – 0 passed.
