

The September 3, 2019 regular meeting of the Cogan House Township Board of Supervisors was called to order at 7:00 PM, at the Municipal Building by Chairman Howard Fry, Board Members attending were Daniel Roupp and Robert Emery. Pledge of Allegiance was given followed by Public comment. Jerry Demorat Chair Person of the Recreation Committee gave an update on how the Fall Festival went. They raised approx. \$1,770.00 for the local Food Pantry, \$900 was raised for the Benefit of Growing Awareness for People group. Due to other conflicting events that weekend the attendance was low over all. The Committee has decided to move their Fall Festival to a different date next year which will be September 12 & 13, 2020. Liberty Volunteer Fire Company was on hand in case of any emergencies.

Supervisor Roupp made a motion to approve the August 6, 2019 Meeting Minutes along with the Bill List and Treasurer's Report. Supervisor Emery seconded was voted 3 – 0 passed.

There were no correspondence.

No EMA, Hazardous Mitigation or WB EMA Report.

ROADMASTERS REPORT: A review of the work that Alta performed on our roads which were Caldwell, Taylor. They also paved the walking trail around the playground which the Township will receive \$2,000.00 Grant monies toward it. Supervisor Roupp spoke with Lester from Range Resources and talked about what needed to be done on Bobst Mountain and Buckhorn Roads. Will need to be milled out and paved with 19 MM. Will need to brush back the road a little before winter so branches do not hit the trucks and breakoff into the road. Need to get the State to take care of Baker Road soon.

Solicitor will attend the court hearing for Mitchell Septic if not settled before on September 17, 2019.
