

A Special Meeting was called and advertised in the Sun Gazette as a Telecommunication meeting on April 27, 2020. The purpose of this meeting was to extend the Declaration of Emergency for Cogan House Township, Lycoming County for another 30 days. Chairman Howard Fry, Supervisor Roupp and Secretary Theresa Roupp attended at the Municipal Building while Supervisor Lori Douglass telecommuted from home. Meeting was brought to order by Chairman Fry at 7:00 PM and it was advertised that if any other business came before the board they would discuss.

The meeting was called due to the Declaration of Emergency was going to run out on April 30, 2020 and as of this date Gov. Wolfe has not opened the state back up without any restrictions. It was the Boards decision to accept a resolution to extend the Declaration for another 30 days which would put us out till May 30, 2020. Chairman Fry made a motion to accept the resolution of extension and Supervisor Douglass seconded, voted and passed 3 – 0.

It was also discussed that during our March meeting that we were unable to correctly use a program to do the telecommunications and discussed that the computer should be updated it has been approx. 8 to 10 years since the previous secretary had updated. With the disaster declaration we can possibly get reimbursed for the expense. The Board felt that a laptop should also be purchased in the instance that work may be done at home if the virus flairs up again. Supervisor Douglass made a motion to purchase a desktop computer and also a laptop for the secretary, Supervisor Roupp seconded, voted 3-0 and passed.

They also decided would do a telecomm for the next meeting in May 5, 2020.
