

The Budget Meeting of the Cogan House Township Board of Supervisors on Saturday October 24, 2020 was called to order at 9:00 AM by Chairman Howard Fry. Supervisors attending Daniel Roupp and Lori Douglass. No residents attended.

The Board discussed some projects for the year 2021. One of them is the building to park the Peterbilt, Mack, and other equipment in and the roof would also cover the recycling bins to make it safer for the public when dropping off in bad weather. The other 2 concerns are Baker Road and Wolfe Run Road. Wolfe Run was never completed in 2020 due to road damage by the pipeline crew when working in early spring. Baker Road is still under consideration by the State to take the road back but needed to maybe put in the budget for next year just in case. This would be budgeted under the Act 13 monies. Another project in mind is foaming the current garage to save on LP heat and also the garage for the fire truck.
