

The March 2, 2021 regular meeting of the Board of Cogan House Supervisors was called to order at 7:00 PM by Chairman Howard Fry with Supervisor Daniel Roupp and Supervisor Lori Douglass in attendance. Residents attending were Tom Sherman, Michell McDermott, Kris Mc Dermott and Mike Fritz. Pledge of allegiance was given.

Public Comment: It was on everybody's mind of a possible nuisance ordinance for curtailing the excessive target shooting in an area of concern. The board advised that it was just in the very beginning of process and a lot needed to be researched and it may not even happen.

No comment from the board about the bill list, treasurer's report and February 2, 2021 minutes. Supervisor Douglass made a motion to approve and accept them, Supervisor Roupp seconded voted and passed 3 – 0.

Correspondence was from Lycoming County Planning and Development for the public hearing that will be held in regards to the proposed Ordinance Text Amendment Package that will amend various sections of the County Zoning Ordinance. The Township received their Liquid Fuel Monies for 2021. They were \$105,616.62 which is down approximately \$10, 000.00 from 2020 and the Turnback monies always stay the same until the state changes it and was \$22,840.00.

No EMA/Hazardous Mitigation report was given.

Road Master Roupp stated that the Township purchased a new 2020 CV International truck with front plow and wing plow. This will also double as a work dump truck when working in replacing/maintaining the roads throughout the year. Tobias fixed Wolf Run Road where Alta put a pipe across the road and settled due to the frost coming out of the ground. Alta paid for that. Some icy patches still around but will not be long before they are gone.

There was no old business.

New Business was a pavilion rental for Deb Gregory on July 18, 2021. The Supervisors decided it was time to put out for the oil bid for the dirt roads. Supervisor Roupp made a motion to advertise Supervisor Douglass seconded, voted 3 – 0 passed. Will open bids at April 6, meeting at 7:10 PM. James V Brown Library was in touch with Lori Douglass about a new MOU contract with Cogan House Township and reopening soon. The Supervisor tabled discussion about it due to the contract was not received in time for the meeting. Status of the building of the permit for the coverage of the recycle bins and storage building for the trucks to keep them out of the weather elements. The plans are nearing completion and should go before County this month, once done we can advertise for bids.

Several Notices of Intents from gas companies were reviewed with no comment.
