

The April 7, 2026 regular meeting of the Board of Cogan House Township Supervisors was called to order at 6:00 PM by Chairman Howard Fry, with Supervisor Luke Short and Supervisor Theresa Roupp attending. The Pledge of Allegiance was given. Approximately 4 residents was in attendance. Public Comment was made by Kathy R. she asked if the Supervisor have thought about the usage of the 4 wheelers on the township roads. Supervisor Roupp and Chairman Fry both agreed that the township could not chance any kind of a law suit that the ATVs may bring and also Supervisor Roupp stated that the road they would like to use is bonded by the gas company and would not be fair in case the 4 wheelers did any kind of damage to the road. The minutes for the March 3, 2026 meeting, Bill List and Treasurer's report was reviewed by the Supervisor's with no comment. Chairman Fry made a motion to approved and accept, Supervisor Short seconded, voted 3 – 0 MC.

6:10 PM The Board opened bids for the 2026 EDP – 30 Dust Retardants. Only one was received from Midland Asphalt Materials, Inc. Their bid amount was for \$1.73 per gallon. It had gone up 2 cents from last year. Supervisor Short made a motion to award the bid to Midland Asphalt Materials, Chairman Fry seconded, voted 3 – 0 MC.

6:20 PM the bids were opened for the 2026 Aggregate Stone bids. Two bids were received, one from Heidelberg Materials Northeast and New Enterprise. The Supervisors reviewed and compared the bids. The bids were very close with Heidelberg submitting a bid of \$186, 800.00 and New Enterprise at \$187,087.00. Heidelberg having the lowest bid. Supervisor Short made a motion to award the bid to Heidelberg Materials Northeast LLC, Chairman Fry seconded, voted 3 – 0 MC.

Correspondence received from PennDot again about the detours for the bridge replacements. West Branch Cog sent invitation to the Equipment Show and Training Day on May 20, 2026. Chairman Fry & Supervisor Short would attend and possibly Bill and Brian also. PennDot also sent out invitation for May 1, 2026 for the Outreach program at the Lycoming Valley Baptist Church from 1-2:30 PM. The Supervisors are not sure if would go to that one. Also received a quote from Ettinger's Landscaping for doing spring spraying & trimming the trees etc. The quote is for \$1,800.00; it did go up from last year but there is no one else that can do it.

There was no report from the EMA/Hazardous Mitigation.

Road Master's report from Chairman Fry was to advise that the cross pipes on Cogan House Road are done. They replaced a pipe on Stryker Road also. The residents also stated complaints about State Route 184 about the ditches in the winter and numerous other problems. Chairman Fry advised he would contact them.

No Old Business. New Business was the request from the recreation committee for their annual donation from the township. The secretary advised that it was not budgeted for 2026. The Supervisors discussed and decided to given them the regular donation fo \$2,000.00 from the general fund. Supervisor Short made a motion to give the donation, Chairman Fry seconded, voted 3 – 0 MC.
