

The August 5, 2025 Regular Meeting of the Board of Supervisors of Cogan House Township was called to order by Chairman Howard Fry, at 6:00 PM with Supervisor Lori Douglass and Supervisor Theresa Roupp attending. There were approximately 7 residents in attendance also. The Pledge of Allegiance was given, with public comment following which there were no comments.

The Minutes, Bill List and Treasurer's report were reviewed with no comments. The Secretary stated that she had transferred \$400,000.00 from the Act 13 account to the Janney account for CD'S or TBs. Supervisor Douglass made a motion to accept and approve the Minutes, Bill List and Treasurer's report, Chairman Fry seconded, voted 3 – 0 MC.

The only correspondence received was the notice for the 2026 Lycoming County Liquid Fuels Grant Application is open from August 8, to September 12, 2025. They have \$150,000.00 available for the projects. Janice L. was not available for a EMA report. Road Master's report was given by Chairman Fry; he advised that pot holes have been filled in and dirt roads have been oiled but noticed that some of the oil has pulled up due to the heat in the afternoon. The possibility of too much dust could also cause it. The men have received some additional training on the township equipment and it has helped them a lot. They will be mowing and do some brushing out along the roads in the next couple of weeks. There was no Old Business.

New Business Cogan House Twp was advise of a new Code Enforcement Officer has been appointed from Michael Baldwin to Sam Musser. Chairman Fry signed the acknowledgement for the secretary to return. Larson Design sent a request for Water Obstruction for a project on Buckhorn Rd, the secretary advised that county will handle this as a third party for storm water and floodplain management. Also, Larson sent the Buckhorn Rd Permit application for signature to submit. Chairman Fry also signed it. From Larson Design also sent a Change Order #1 for the Turnback project on Cogan House Road due to the length of time it took for the permits to come back from DEP and Army Corp. Chairman Fry made a motion to accept the Change Order, Supervisor Douglass seconded, voted 3 – 0 MC. Contract received from Larson for the contractor Gutelius to be signed and to begin on the Cogan House Rd. project. Chairman Fry signed that also. DEP & Army Corp. requested signatures in acceptance and acknowledgment for the PASPGP-6 (NPDES) permit for Cogan House Road. Pavillion rental for August 21, 2025 was approved. Letters of Intent received from Larson Design for culvert replacement on Buckhorn Road they will submit to DEP. Seneca Resources intent for consumptive use of water for drilling for the DCNR 100 Pad C not to exceed 4 million gals per day in Cogan House Twp. Signed Payroll – Chairman Fry made motion to adjourn the meeting at 6:35 PM, Supervisor Douglass seconded.
