

The June 3, 2025 Regular Meeting of the Board of Supervisors of Cogan House Township was called to order by Chairman Howard Fry, at 6:00 PM with Supervisor Lori Douglass and Supervisor Theresa Roupp attending. There were approximately 5 residents also attending. The Pledge of Allegiance was given with public comment immediately following. Kathy R. asked questions whether the township receives any money from the gas wells. Chairman Fry explained that the township receives money from the Stryker and Vollman pads, but only amounts to \$200.00 on an average. Chairman Fry brought an issue with the election stating that the sample ballot was taped on the door (front and back door) with the names of write ins on it. He explained that it is not allowed, any write ins must be 10 feet from the building only. The Minutes, Bill List and Treasurer's Report for May 2025 were reviewed with no comment. Supervisor Douglass made a motion to accept and approve them, Chairman Fry seconded, voted 3 – 0, MC.

There was no correspondence. The EMA Coordinator was not present so there was no report. Chairman Fry gave the Road Master's Report stating that they have been filling potholes and have started mowing along the side of the roads.

There was no Old Business.

New Business were 2 pavilion rentals for June 7, 2025 and July 6, 2025. The Supervisors approved the rentals.

Letter of Intent was from Chesapeake Energy (part of Expand Energy) for applying for a permit to drill a well on the Elly May pad.
