

The March 3, 2026 regular meeting of the Board of Cogan House Supervisors was called to order at 600 PM by Chairman Howard Fry, with Supervisor Luke Short and Supervisor Theresa Roupp attending. The Pledge of Allegiance was given. Approximately 10 residents attending with guests Doug Brion and Denny Hawkins as guests on the agenda. (Included in the count). The only public comment was from the Secretary announcing that the Easter Egg Hunt would take place at the township on March 28, 2026 at 100 PM. No further comments.

The Minutes from the February 3, 2026 Meeting was reviewed along with the Bill List and Treasurer's report with no comment. Supervisor Short made a motion to approve them with Chairman Fry seconded, voted 3 – 0 MC.

Correspondence received was from the Liberty VFC with a thank you for the donation the Township sent out. Penn-Dot sent their remittance for the Liquid Fuels for 2026 which will be received on March 2, 2026 in the amount of \$104,166.08 which was down from last year by \$1,223.27. The Turn Back amount stays the same at \$49,960.00. The detour route for Nestlerode Contractor was received advising that Rout 184 will be the detour when they replace the state bridge on Cogan House Road at the intersection of Cemetery Road. Rescom Telecommunication is advising of a communication tower being place near White Pine asking of any issues with the township. The Supervisors agreed there were no issues with this but a zoning permit will be required.

No report from the EMA.

Road Master's report was given by Chairman Fry advising that there is approx. 30 cross pipes remaining to be completed on Cogan House Rd. The contractors are moving along with little or no issues other than weather conditions. Some of the side roads are getting soft due to frost going out.

No Old Business.

New Business was a Pavilion rental for July 25, 2026. Doug Brion wanted to address the Supervisors about allowing ATVs on a portion of the Township roads. The road he was asking about was Bobst Mt. from Lewis Twp line to Buckhorn Rd, continuing on Buckhorn to Cogan House Rd, to White Pine intersection of Rt 184. He has gone to the surrounding townships asking the same and if everyone agrees the next step is to go to Penn-Dot for their permission. The Supervisors would consider but Chairman Fry advised right up front that is no way to regulate the restrictions and that we would still be liable if something would happen. Tabled for the time being. It's the time of year to put out our bids for Aggregate Stone. Chairman Fry made a motion to go ahead and advertisement with the same amounts as last year, Supervisor Short seconded, voted 3 – 0 MC. The same with the EDP-30 dust retardant to be advertised for bid, Supervisor Short made the motion, Chairman Fry seconded, voted 3 – 0 MC. Also, the Board advised they would like to bid for Contractor w/ operator for 2026. The secretary inquired how they would like to do this. Chairman Fry advised that should do with a list of equipment and size. Township crew will flag if need be. Chairman Fry made a motion to advertise for contractor

for 2026, Supervisor Short seconded, voted 3 – 0 MC. Chairman Fry advised that there is a pipe on Stryker Road that needs replaced. The Secretary did some preliminary research as far as permits go with Larson Design. They reached out to DEP and was advised no permit was required due to no wetlands, but should check with Conservation District to be sure no requirements are needed other than E & S Plan.

Letter of Intents from ARM Group on behalf of Range Resources applying for coverage under general permit WMGR 123 processing & beneficial use of oil and gas liquid waste from PADEP at 3462 Steam Mill Rd (Laurel Hill) for storage tank. EQT notice of intent for Consumptive use of water for the Knispel Pad A in Cogan House Twp not to exceed 4 million gals per day.

Payroll was signed.

Chairman Fry made a motion to adjourn the meeting at 715 PM, Supervisor Short seconded, voted 3 – 0 MC.
