

The March 5, 2024 Regular Meeting of the Board of Supervisors of Cogan House Township was called to order by Vice-Chairperson Lori Douglass with Supervisor Daniel Roupp attending and Supervisor Howard Fry not attending. Approximately 6 residents attended. Pledge of Allegiance was given.

Public Comment – N. Martin asked about the bridges being repaired in 2025 and asked if would be done at the same time. Supervisor Roupp advised no they would be done separately and detours would be put in place. However, it is not clear how the Buckhorn Road Bridge repair would be handled at this time.

The February 6, 2024 minutes, bill list and treasurer's report were tabled due to Supervisor Fry not being present and Supervisor Douglass was not present at the February meeting.

Bidding Opening at 6:10 PM for the 2024 Stone Aggregate – There were 2 bids submitted. New Enterprise Stone & Lime Co. of Lewisburg, PA submitted a bid for a total of \$178,053.75 for the advertised items and Heidelberg Materials of Montoursville, PA submitted a bid of a total of \$164,725.00 which was the lowest of the 2. Vice Chair Lori Douglass made a motion to award the bid to Heidelberg Materials, Supervisor Roupp seconded, voted 2 – 0 MC. Immediately following the bids for the 2024 EDP – 30 Dust Retardant was opened. There were 3 bids submitted. Russell Standard of Fayetteville, PA submitted a bid at \$2.37 per gallon total of \$54,510.00, Suite – Kote Corporation of Hallstead, PA submitted a bid of \$2.35 per gallon total of \$54,050.00, and Midland Asphalt Materials, INC of Bloomsburg, PA submitted a bid of \$1.65 per gallon a total of \$7,950.00. Midland had the lowest bid, Vice Chair Lori Douglass made a motion to award the bid to Midland Asphalt, Supervisor Roupp seconded, voted 2 – 0 MC. Correspondence was a letter from Rep. Joseph Hamm advising he would be at the Trout Run Fire Hall and requesting that the Municipal representatives of the Township be present. He wanted to keep them apprised of what is happening in Harrisburg at the present time. Bradco Supply advised of save the date September 26, 2024. The Planning & Community Development WATS program is open for review by the public.

EMA/Hazardous Mitigation - Janice L. was not present.

Road Master's report – Supervisor Roupp advised that with a early spring they would start filling pot holes and see what road repairs will need to be done in 2024. Waiting for the approval of permitting for Cogan House Road so it can be put out to bid. PennDOT still planning bridge repairs or replacement in 2025.

Old Business – The Salt Contract Bid needs to be in by March 15, 2024. Supervisor Roupp would like to take the remaining 100 T from previous year contract in case the price increases 2024/25. That would leave a bid for 125 T for the new contract.

New Business – Pavilion rentals for July 27, 2024 supervisors approved. Employment application received from Mary Jones for outside grounds work. Vice Chair Douglass made a motion to accept and approve, Supervisor Roupp seconded, voted 2 – 0.

Letter of Intent – Larson Design advised of intent to file a joint permit for Cogan House Road repairs with DEP and the Conservation District. Range Resources intent to submit to Susquehanna River Basin for consumptive use of water for drilling & development of pad 1H for the Porter Stephen in Cogan House Township.
