

The September 24, 2024 Regular Meeting (rescheduled from September 3, 2024) of the Cogan House Township Board of Supervisors was called to order by Chairman Howard Fry, with Supervisor Lori Douglass attending. Pledge of Allegiance was given with a moment of silence for the passing of Supervisor Daniel L. Roupp. Approximately 17 residents attended.

Public Comment there was none.

The Supervisors reviewed the August 6, 2024 Minutes, Bill List and Treasurer's Report with no comment. Supervisor Douglass made a motion to accept, Chairman Fry seconded, voted 2 – 0 MC. Darla K asked what the invoice from Farmer Boy was for the Secretary advised was for all the hydroseeding on Cogan House Road.

Correspondence was received from Lycoming County Board of Reassessment that they are proceeding with the reassessment this year and somebody will be coming to the resident's home. The salt contract was awarded to Cargill again with a price of \$74.75 for Lycoming County. PennDot was advising of the detour for SR 4001 going to Waterville however it has sent been opened. The taxes for the PA Game Commission were raised from \$1.20 to \$2.40 in some cases which would double what we would receive. The township received the Fire Relief Allocation of \$7,607.95 which will be split between Morris VF and Trout Run VF. An email received from Range Resources advising that there will be no more heavy truck traffic or any fracking in the future only maintenance vehicles on Post Road. They would like to cut the berm where they used it for staging of the trucks. The Supervisors would take it under advisement.

EMA/HAZAROUS MITIGATION: There was none.

Roadmasters Report: Employee Bill M. advised that mowing is almost completed. EQT is looking to stockpile 2A Subbase at the township and also some rock from the Fulkerson pad.

Tom S asked about the dirt and stone from the pad what it was Chairman Fry said was 2 A subbase and other is just rock but it cannot be given to Residents and the owner of the pad. Residents concerned with the Commissioners allowing the multi housing initiative that Gov Shapiro signed into law.
